TCCA Members:

The Texas Court Clerks Association will follow the direction of leaders across the State concerning the recent COVID-19 developments.

With President Trump's declaration of a nation emergency and Governor Abbott's declaration of a state of disaster in Texas, all TCCA sponsored training and Chapter Meetings scheduled through **May 31, 2020** will be cancelled effective immediately.

The TCCA Education Committee has changed the current continuing education requirements for the Clerk Certification Program. All Clerks currently certified at Level 1 or Level 2 will be allowed to obtain 12 hours of education through TMCEC's Online Learning Center. All Level 3 Clerks will be allowed to obtain 20 hours of education in the same manner. **Online hours may be live or archived and will be accepted for TMCEC webinars only.** <https://tmcec.remote-learner.net/>

This is a temporary change; this exception is only for the current academic year which ends August 31, 2020. Please understand, the Education Committee will NOT entertain appeals that result from a lack of training hours.

This is new territory for most of us, many of us have children that are not allowed to go to school, employees unable to come to work, family members with health concerns and constantly changing policies in our own communities – it is TCCA's intention to make continuing education one less thing you have to worry about.
